Many stood to pray and rededicate their lives to Christ with a new understanding and commitment. Then we all enjoyed lunch after church together. (Lunch was sandwiches made Saturday afternoon by our fabulous intern team.)

...and Monday was Family Day, a public holiday in South Africa. We were snuggled up on couches, watching a funny movie, and enjoying a day of rest. We hope that each of you had an enjoyable and powerful Resurrection season with your families!


Spiritual Victories!

As the mothers learn the deceit of Satan who provides lying demons to claim to be ancestors, they are acting on their faith and cutting the literal ties that bind their children. Dinie Estates







Dinie Estates is the community that neighbours our Hope property. During the week that a team from Calvary Church in Springfield, IL was here to work with us, they helped facilitate our first outreach to our neighbours! There were more than 270 kids and another 30+adults and teens in attendance. At the outreach, they all heard about Jesus, received a Book of Hope, and were told that we would be starting a new church soon. There was SO much interest in a church -especially a church with a focus on children's ministry. Even now, kids drop by the gate from time to time to ask when the jumping castles will be back and when the church will start.

So here is our big announcement: the target date for the launch of Hope Church in Dinie estates is Sunday, May 26, with an outreach on the 25th to spread the word! Initially, we will launch the new location for Hope Church as an open-air church with KidMin-style family services. (In other words, we will do kids' church and invite adults to join us until we have funds and a teaching team to create an additional space for an adult service to run simultaneously.)

We have been discussing this with our Hope Church board of directors and have decided to treat the new location for Hope Church as a "daughter church" or church plant of Hope Church in Freedom Park. We are ONE family, separated by distance.

Please continue to pray for our neighbours. Pray for salvation for the people of Dinie Estates. Pray for discipleship through Hope Church. Pray for wisdom as we move forward with planting another church. Pray for favour for us and for Hope Church in the community. Pray for resources at the proper time. Pray for our family, especially our children, as we step into the spiritual battle involved in planting a church in yet another location that Satan thinks he owns. We know that the territory already belongs to Jesus... but He commissions us to take it back.

In addition to the Dinie Estates outreach and other projects, the team from Calvary Church in Springfield, IL also sponsored and facilitated a camp at Jackson's Ridge Children's Ministry Training Centre. About 40 children from Hope Church in Freedom Park were able to go to camp. It was fun, exciting, and life-changing for them.
