# We are SO excited by what God is doing in the hearts and lives of the people of Freedom Park!

Our kids, about 100-120 each week, have memorized the books of the New Testament in Tswana (the most common language in the schools) and are learning to find scriptures in their Bibles. They are also memorizing



Bible verses and praying with passion. We have even been able to start a Jr. Leaders team with some of the older kids. We are so proud of them!

The adults of Hope Church, about 25 each week, are becoming disciples and evangelists! They decided that a Sunday service was just not enough, so they have started 3 home groups



that meet during the week. Many of their neighbors have begun attending the home groups, and some have started attending the church as well. Thank you to those of you who donated toward the purchase of chairs for the adults! As you can see, we are all very happy and very grateful!!





Well, Lighthouse Children's Shelter has gone through yet another transition! The local Assembly of God church that took over LCS wants the property to have the maximum community impact possible but was growing frustrated by the interaction with the government Department of Social Development and other "nuts and bolts" aspects of running a place of safety. So God opened a door for an interesting partnership. A place of safety in a near-by town, called Grace Help Centre, was looking desperately for a way to expand into Rustenburg... with no money for property, buildings, staff, or supplies.

So, the decision was made to close LCS and allow Grace Help Centre to operate in this facility, with help and support from the church.

So, of course, our roles have also transitioned. Jeff is still overseeing the grounds and maintenance staff, but Abby is no longer as highly involved with the shelter. Abby has now become more of a shelter consultant for the new house mother as she works toward getting the new shelter registered! She and Beth enjoy visiting the 4 babies that are currently here and look forward to many more.
